**Halifax Health has served as the leading provider of healthcare in our community for 82 years. Let's take a closer look at the benefits.**

### **Service to Uninsured Patients = \$31.8 million**

### **Medicaid and Medicare Deficits = \$26.5 million**

The health system spent more than **\$31.8 million** in FY09 to care for patients who were under- or uninsured. This number does not include the **\$26.5 million** that was spent subsidizing Medicaid and Medicare deficits.

### **Physician Services = \$7.5 million**

The medical staff at Halifax Health consists of more than 500 area physicians, representing 46 medical subspecialties who serve our community's healthcare needs.

### **Trauma Center = \$4.6 million**

Halifax Health operates the only Trauma Center in the area. This means that trained professionals including trauma surgeons, specialists and staff are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to care for the area's most emergent healthcare needs. In FY09, Halifax Health spent **\$4.6 million** to maintain its promise to the community that no matter the emergency, the Trauma Center at Halifax Health is here to serve.

### **Preventive Health Services = \$1.3 million**

Through local clinics and programs such as Healthy Communities, Halifax Health contributed **\$1.3 million** to preventive health services in FY09.

### **Neonatal and Pediatric Intensive Care Units = \$0.9 million**

The area's only 24-hour Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) and the only Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) are located at Halifax Health. These services guarantee 24-hour care for babies and children in our community.

### **Child and Adolescent Behavioral Services = \$0.5 million**

Halifax Health - Behavioral Services is the only organization of its kind in the area. Halifax Health contributed **\$0.5 million** in FY09 to provide Psychiatric and Psychological services to children and adolescents, as well as individual, family and group counseling.

### **Total Benefit to the Community = \$74.8 million**

During fiscal year 2009 (FY09), Halifax Health provided abundant benefits to the community resulting in a total contribution equal to **\$74.8 million**.
