STAMFORD, CT/November 7, 2008 – Stamford Hospital has recently named Dr. Marc Brodsky the Medical Director for the new Center for Integrative Medicine & Wellness. In addition to this role, he oversees the pain management program at the Center. Dr. Brodsky comes to Stamford Hospital from UCLA, where he was an Assistant Clinical Professor under the Department of Medicine.

Dr. Brodsky is a Diplomate of the National Board of Medical Examiners and the American Board of Family Medicine, and he is licensed to practice in the states of Connecticut, New York, Hawaii, and California. He served as a Navy physician in California, Hawaii, Korea, and Japan. After his military experience, he received fellowship training in Integrative Medicine at UCLA. At that institution, he also completed a masters of public health; a fellowship in medical education from the Office of Dean of Education, Development, and Research; and the Graduate Training Program in Translational Investigation, also known as the K30, that was developed by an NIH grant to train clinicians in patient-oriented clinical research.

Dr. Brodsky earned a bachelor of arts degree in political science from the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor and a medical degree from Hahnemann University in Pennsylvania. He completed his internship at Naval Hospital Oakland in Oakland, California and his residency at Naval Hospital Camp Pendleton in Camp Pendleton, California. Dr. Brodsky earned his MBA from Regis University in Denver, Colorado.
