REQUEST FOR REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS

Under the American Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, persons with disabilities are entitled to reasonable accommodations during their health care visit at Virginia Hospital Center. If you require special accommodations for your visit, please notify the registration clerk, scheduling clerk or nursing staff on admission.
