

# inData TrialDirector® 5.1 (BUILD 663)

## RELEASE NOTES

inData Corporation released a patch for TrialDirector® v5.1 on May 5, 2008. This patch applies to single-user licenses and can be downloaded using the Online Update feature in TrialDirector (Start Menu > TrialDirector 5 > Check for Updates). Below is a synopsis of the enhancements and fixes in build 663.

### SAVE “PRINT SLIPSHEETS” OPTION

When a user selects the “Print Slipsheets” option in the print dialog, TrialDirector now saves that preference and the designated print tray assignment, even after the user closes the print dialog. The preference will remain selected until the user un-checks the “Print Slipsheets” box. Previously, the “Print Slipsheets” option would re-set when the user closed the print dialog.

### SELECT ANY PRINTER TRAY

TrialDirector now allows the user to select any tray on their printer to print documents from TrialDirector. Previously, the program would only print to the user’s default print tray.

### SUMMATION INTEGRATION ENHANCEMENTS

#### Summation Multi-Page TIF Page Count

- › TrialDirector now obtains the page count when a user transfers multi-page .tif files from Summation using the “Get Summation Image Info” menu selection in TrialDirector.

#### Summation Images Using Semi-Colons

- › Sending images from Summation iBlaze to TrialDirector using the “Add Item Image(s) to TrialDirector” or “Display Image in TrialDirector Presentation Mode” has been enhanced to accommodate multiple file names that are separated by the semi-colon character within the “ImgFiles” field of the IMGINFO table.

**Note:** The integration between TrialDirector and CT Summation iBlaze must be configured for these features to work. ### TAGGING MULTIPLE PAGES OF MIXED FILES DOCUMENT

A user can now tag all the pages of a document that contains mixed, multiple file types (e.g. .tif, .jpg, .bmp) for its pages, even when the document is collapsed in the Case Explorer.
