This offer is valid for residential customers only.

Eligibility: Incentives are available to all CL&P and UI residential electric service customers. Equipment must be installed in the service territory of the participating electric utility. Eligible systems are: electric heat pumps (air source) and electric central air conditioning. All split systems must be matched and ARI¹ -rated as such in order to meet program requirements.

Proof of Purchase: An invoice itemizing the purchased equipment must accompany each incentive Application. The invoice copy must indicate the equipment type, make and model numbers and the date of purchase.

Application: This Application must be filled out completely, truthfully and accurately. The Customer and Contractor must each sign and submit the completed Application along with the invoice.

Payment: Please allow up to 90 days for payment. Payment processing may take longer if information is missing on the Application. Please Call 1-800-456-5983 if you have any questions about your incentive.

Approval and Verification: Your electric utility reserves the right to verify sales transaction and to have reasonable access to your residence to inspect the system installed under this program, prior to issuing incentives, for up to one year after date of application.

Tax Liability: Your electric utility will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Customer as a result of the payment of incentives.

Endorsement: Your electric utility does not endorse any particular manufacturer, product, or system design in promoting this program.

Limitation of Liability: Your electric utility's liability is limited to paying the incentive specified. The electric utility is not liable for any consequential or incidental damages, or for any damages in tort connected with or resulting from participation in this program.

ISO-NE Capacity Payments: By signing this document, and as a condition for receiving a rebate pursuant to this program, Customer hereby assigns to its participating electric utility, either CL&P or UI, whichever the case may be, all of its rights, title and interest in and to any and all LICAP, ICAP, or any and all other capacity-related credits or payments for which Customers may be eligible for ISO-NE or such value associated with the settlement of such LICAP, ICAP, or capacity payments as determined through the ISO-NE LICAP, ICAP, or other such like capacity supply auction or market (or its successors or replacements) for any capacity enrolled with ISO-NE.

Class III Conservation Credits: In accordance with the Department of Public Utility Control's June 28, 2006 decision in Docket No. 05-07-19, DPUC Proceeding to Develop a New Distributed Resources Portfolio Standard, Customer is not eligible to receive or retain any Class III conservation credits for this project. Such credits shall be retained by either CL&P or UI for the benefit of their customers through the CEEF. Customer may be eligible to receive and retain Class III conservation credits for projects which do not receive funding from the CEEF. Such projects would be treated as separate projects under the Class III credit program.
