

# Educational Opportunities

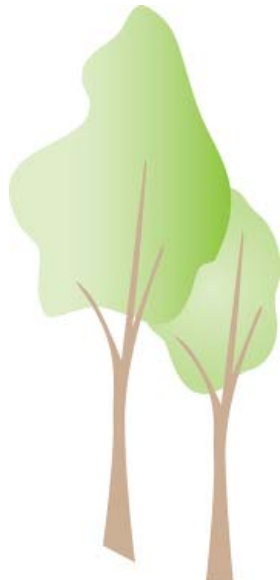
*ACES* is an exciting new program of educational opportunities for Villagers.
